1) God's Kingdom of Grace and Glory <i>Luke 17:20-21 Philippians 3:20-21</i>	"For our citizenship is in heaven, from which also we eagerly wait for a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ." <i>Philippians 3:20</i> Enrichment Memory Verse: Philippians 3:21	<i>The Second Petition:</i> Thy Kingdom Come
2) How Does God's Kingdom Come to Us? <i>Genesis 15:1-6</i>	"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life." <i>John 3:16</i> Enrichment Memory Verse: John 14:6	<i>What does this mean?</i> The kingdom of God comes indeed of itself, without our prayer; but we pray in this petition that it may come also to us.
3) God's Kingdom: All Are Invited <i>Matthew 22:1-14</i>	"Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes has eternal life." <i>John 6:47</i> Enrichment Memory Verse: II Corinthians 2:15	<i>How is this done?</i> When our heavenly Father gives us His Holy Spirit, so that by His grace we believe His holy Word . . .
4) God Keeps Us for Heaven <i>John 14:1-3 Psalm 121:5-8</i>	"The Lord will protect you from all evil; He will keep your soul. The Lord will guard your going out and your coming in from this time forth and forever." <i>Psalm 121:7-8</i> Enrichment Memory Verse: John 14:2	<i>How is this done?</i> . . . and live a godly life here on earth, and in heaven for ever.
5) God's Will Is That We Praise Him <i>I Chronicles 29:10-22</i>	"Let the peoples praise Thee, O God; let all the peoples praise Thee." <i>Psalm 67:3</i> Enrichment Memory Verse: Hebrews 13:15	<i>The Third Petition:</i> Thy will be done.
6) God's Will Is That We Be Saved <i>Luke 22:39-46</i>	"For this is the will of My Father, that everyone who beholds the Son and believes in Him, may have eternal life; and I Myself will raise him up on the last day." <i>John 6:40</i> Enrichment Memory Verse: I Timothy 2:4	<i>What does this mean?</i> The good and gracious will of God is done indeed without our prayer; but we pray in this petition that it may be done also among us.
7) God's Will Is That We Stand Against Satan Acts 4:18-31 (<i>Teacher's Manual – summarize verses 1-17 to lead into lesson</i>)	"But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us." <i>Romans 8:37</i> Enrichment Memory Verse: I Corinthians 15:57	<i>How is this done?</i> When God destroys and brings to naught every evil counsel and purpose of the devil, the world, and our own flesh, which would hinder us from hallowing His Name, and prevent the coming of His kingdom . . .
8) God's Will Is to Strengthen and Keep Us <i>Luke 22:31-34, 54-62</i>	"The Lord is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in Him, and I am helped." <i>Psalm 28:7a</i> Enrichment Memory Verse: Joshua 1:9	<i>How is this done?</i> . . .and when He strengthens us and keeps us steadfast in His Word and in faith, even unto our end. This is His good and gracious will.
9) God Provides Our Daily Bread <i>Exodus 16:1-15, 31</i>	<i>And my God shall supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.</i> <i>Philippians 4:19</i> Enrichment Memory Verse: Matthew 6:25	<i>The Fourth Petition:</i> Give us this day our daily bread.
10) Be Content with Daily Bread <i>Matthew 6:25-34</i>	<i>Oh give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; for His lovingkindness is everlasting.</i> <i>Psalm 107:1</i> Enrichment Memory Verse:	<i>What does this mean?</i> God indeed gives daily bread to all men, even to the wicked, without our prayer; but we pray in this petition that He would lead us to acknowledge or daily bread as His gift, and to receive it with thanksgiving.
11) Be Thankful for Daily Bread <i>Ephesians 5:20 Luke 17:11-19</i>	<i>Always giving thanks for all things in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to God, even the Father.</i> <i>Ephesians 5:20</i> Enrichment Memory Verse: Colossians 3:17	<i>What is meant by daily bread?</i> Everything that is required to satisfy our bodily needs; such as food and raiment, house and home, fields and flocks, money and goods . . .
12) Ask and Work for Daily Bread <i>Luke 5:1-7</i>	Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than for men. <i>Colossians 3:23</i> Enrichment Memory Verse: Colossians 3:24	<i>What is meant by daily bread?</i> . . . pious parents, children, and servants; godly and faithful rulers, good government; seasonable weather, peace and health; order and honor; true friends, good neighbors, and the like.
