

# THE WONDERFUL NAME OF GOD

**Bible Lesson:**  
**Exodus 3:7-17**



When you talk to someone for the first time, what do you think you might say to that person? Would you ask the person, "What is your name?" Knowing a person's name is one of the first things you want to know about someone.

In the Bible, God tells us His name. God appeared in a burning bush to a man named Moses and told him to lead the children of Israel out of Egypt, to the Promised Land. Moses said, "When the people ask me what Your name is, what shall I tell them?" God said, "Tell them My name is I AM."

The name "I AM" sounds like a strange name to us. But it is a very wonderful name. The word "LORD" is another way of saying "I AM." The words "I AM" reveal many things about God. They tell us that God is real. They tell us that God is alive. They tell us that God is eternal. He will live forever. God always has been alive, and He always will be alive. He has power over all things. He is also the Savior. When we use the name "LORD," we mean all these wonderful things about God.

Many hundreds of years after God told Moses His name, Jesus the Son of God also called Himself "I AM." Jesus is God. Jesus is LORD. Jesus is real and alive. He is eternal and will live forever. Jesus has power over all things because He is God. Jesus showed His power when He performed miracles on earth. He showed His power over sin when He died on the cross for the sins of the world. He showed His power over death when He rose again from the grave. Because Jesus is God, He can save us from our sins. Because He is alive forever, He can give eternal life to all who believe in Him. When we use the name "LORD," we mean all these wonderful things about Jesus.

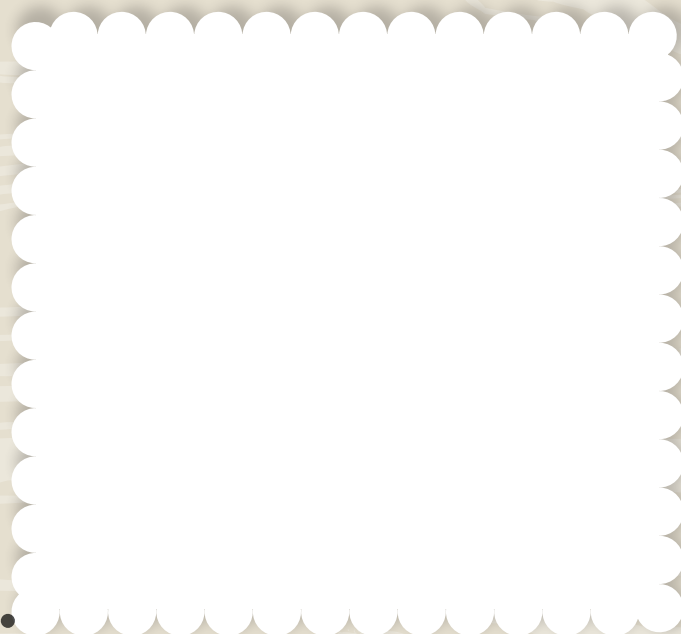
