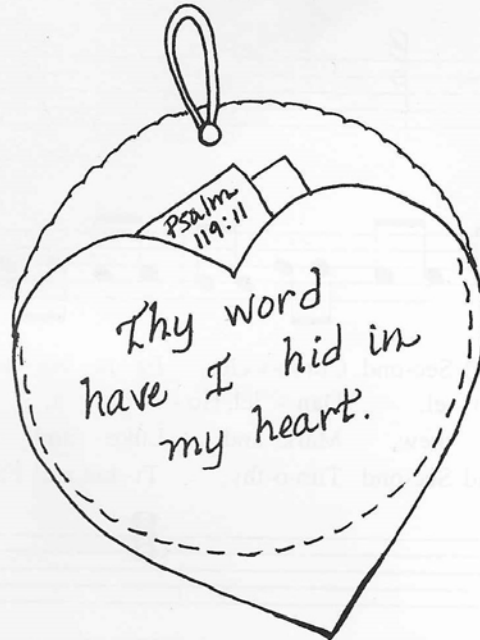
Thy Word have I hid in my heart, That I might not sin a - gainst Thee;

Bible Memory Verse Basket

Materials:

- * two paper plates
- * marker
- * scissors
- * stapler
- * hole punch
- * yarn or ribbon
- * decorative trim



Cut one paper plate to form a heart. On the heart-shaped plate, write the verse from Psalm 119:11, "Thy word have I hid in my heart." Match the side edges with the other paper plate, layering them together to form a pocket. Staple the two plates or punch holes around the outer edges and lace the plates together with yarn or ribbon. You may also want to decorate the plates with glitter or stickers. Punch a hole at the top and make a loop with yarn or ribbon to hang the basket on your classroom wall.

After you have learned the Bible memory verse each week, place the activity sheet or a 3" x 5" memory verse card into the holder. Use the memory basket to regularly review memory verses with your class each week. Remind students that we are hiding God's Word in our hearts when we read the Bible and memorize Bible verses.
