

THY WORD IS TRUTH ACTIVITY

Supplies needed: construction paper, scissors, glue, ribbon (optional)

The student will be making a “Bible.” Although the student may not be able to read all the words in the verses on the pages of the “Bible,” they can listen as you read.

SAY: Many Old Testament Scriptures were written by prophets. The prophets were men called by God to tell what would happen in the future. The prophets told about Jesus many years before Jesus was born. The promises that were foretold about Jesus came true.

This is the important point of our lesson today. God has always been faithful to His Word. Because God is faithful and true, we can always trust that “Thy word is truth.”

Have students carefully **CUT** the activity in half on the solid line.

Give student the half sheet of construction paper, folded in half.

PUT a thin strip of **GLUE** on the fold line of the construction paper.

FOLD the cut activity pages on the broken line. Place the pages marked 1 and 6 facing up with the fold on the glue line.

PUT a thin strip of **GLUE** along the broken line on this page. Place the pages marked 3 and 4 face up on this glue line.

An optional ribbon can be attached with glue at the top middle of this center section. **FOLD** “Bible” closed.

Open and **READ** the verse to students. Discuss how Jesus fulfilled the promises from the Old Testament.
