Answers for Quarter 1, Lesson 10

- 1. The centurion wanted Jesus to speak authoritatively and heal his servant (from a distance) who was seriously ill.
- 2. Jesus said, ""Truly I say to you, I have not found such great faith with anyone in Israel."
- 3. Jesus told the centurion to go on his way and that the healing would take place as he had believed. The centurion's servant was healed "that very moment."
- 4. Jesus' authority over the body is seen in the miracle of healing the servant in that even a very serious illness is driven from the body by Jesus' power.
- 5. Jesus got up and rebuked the wind and said to the sea, "Hush, be still."
- 6. The wind died down and it became perfectly calm.
- 7. Jesus' authority over nature is seen in the miracle of the calming of the sea in that even the powerful forces of nature submit to Him as He commands them.
- 8. The demon acknowledge that Jesus was "the Holy One of God."
- 9. Jesus rebuked him, saying, "Be quiet and come out of him!"
- 10. Even though the demon had thrown the man down in the midst of the people, he came out of him without doing him any harm.
- 11. The people acknowledged that with authority and power Jesus commands the unclean spirits and they obey.
- 12. Jesus' authority over demons is seen in this miracle of deliverance in that the powerful demonic forces must submit to Him and to His Word.
- 13. Jesus told them, "The child has not died, but is asleep." (Jesus meant that the child's death was not permanent.)
- 14. Jesus said, "Talitha kum!" (which translated means, "Little girl, I say to you, get up!").
- 15. Immediately the girl got up and began to walk.
- 16. Jesus' authority over death is seen in this miracle of the raising to life of a twelve year old girl in that even the power of death must submit to Him and to His Word.
- 17. Individual answers will vary.
- 18. The examples of Jesus' authority help me to trust Him more as I recognize that no problem—no matter how great it seems—is too hard for Him to overcome for me.
