- 2. The wise man is compared to the person who hears God's Word and does what it says. He has a solid foundation on which to build and live his life.
- 3. The foolish man is compared to the person who hears the Word of God and does not act on it. He who builds his life ignoring Jesus' teachings has no solid foundation on which to build and live his life.
- 4. Jesus taught as one having authority.
- 5. The people were amazed at His teaching.
- 6. The people found Jesus' teaching difficult to accept, and many disciples no longer followed Him.
